

A Message from the Chief Executive Commissioner

HE above is my message for 1939 to brother Cubs, Scouts and Rovers. You can all read it, I am sure, even the Cubs who have passed their Second Stars. It is an important message and should be borne in mind throughout the Year.

Their Majesties, the King and Queen, are to be in Canada this year and our Association wants to celebrate the event by reaching a total membership of ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND. We can do it IF YOU DON'T QUIT.

At the beginning of 1935 we promised the Chief Scout for Canada that we would do our best to have One Hundred Thousand by the end of 1939. At that time there were 65,828 of us, now there are 95,327. This means that we have grown at the rate of more than 7,000 a year. So you see we need just 4,673 more to enable us to reach our goal and to make good our promise.

But I think I hear you saying: "What can I do to help? I am only one among so many."

The answer is: Don't Quit! Every year more than 30,000 boys leave Scouting and we must get others to take their places, and then some more, before we can show an increase. This means that last year 30,000 boys dropped out and 37,000 boys came in. Would it not have been wonderful if the 30,000 hadn't found it necessary to drop out?

My message, therefore, to you for 1939—a very important one—is DON'T QUIT! Stay with your Pack, your Troop or your Crew and let's celebrate the coming of the King and Queen by being able to report to them at the end of 1939 that at last we have reached the ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND mark.

So, Don't Quit!





The Boy Scout Camp Uniform has been designed specially for wear at Camp, on Hikes etc. It will save your "Official" uniform some of the harder knocks so liable to happen in camp, and then it's so much cooler and free-er looking for those hot summer months. The shirt is of a light weight khaki drill with an open V-neck [no collar], short 1/4 length sleeves, official [detachable] buttons and Boy Scouts-Canada badge. The shorts are of heavier khaki drill cut in the standard Scout pattern, while the stockings are of plain khaki wool. The regulation hat, belt and Troop neckerchief completes the outfit.

Lady Cubmaster's Uniform

While no standard outfit has been laid down in P.O. and R., it is expected that Ladies would be careful to conform as closely to the Chief Scout's idea of what constitutes the "Official" dress, as circumstances may permit.

To make this possible Headquarters has now made available a Lady Cubmaster's uniform which conforms to the "Official" dress as laid down by the Chief Scout.

The outfit consists of the regulation Hat, [we recommend the Rover Scout Hat listed on page 3 as being the most suitable] a Coat-Frock which is available in either All-Wool Gaberdine of excellent quality in a smart Khaki shade, or Khaki Cotton Twill which is recommended for warm weather use. Regulation Leaders' Belt featured on page 6, and Neckerchief conforming in colour to that worn by the Pack. Stockings and Shoes are not provided for and should be purchased to individual taste.

The Coat-Frock is a one piece garment having two large lower pockets and two smaller pockets at top, all with button-down flaps. The neck is the open V-cut style with a turned down collar, while the sleeves are cut short to the elbow. The "Official" Wolf-Cubs Canada embroidered badge is sewn on right breast. The outfit is smart, comfortable and is highly recommended.


