What is JOTT?

This is your once a year opportunity to participate in a Worldwide Scouting event at little or no cost. **WOW!** How often does that happen?

Jamboree On The Trail is an annual day for the World Scout Movement to hike together. It's easy to remember the date — it's always the 2nd Saturday of May, each and every year. JOTT is the only international annual event for every member of the Scouting family - members of all ages and all sections. It is an ideal opportunity to come together in the spirit of Scouting, with members from all over the world promoting the worldwide aspect of this great Movement. Whatever age and wherever you may be in the world, you are invited to participate any way you can.

Take an afternoon, day or weekend; go for a walk, a hike, a camp; do a community service project, or whatever activity is suitable for you or your group. Participate individually or as a group. Just imagine, many other Scouting members will be out there too, on the same day, worldwide.

The first Jamboree on the Trail was held in 1998. Every year it grows bigger and bigger. Each year sees more countries and more members participating. There is no official recognition for the event, no funding for publicity, just the Internet and word of mouth to spread the news. Nonetheless, this event is catching the imagination of a great number of Scouting and Guiding members.

Registration

The form is available on our web site (see below). There are two ways to register, first, with a crest-order by mail, or, secondly, without a crest-order by e-mail or mail. Registration helps us to determine how many participants we have.

Crest

A new crest is designed each year, available for purchase by participants. Scouter J. Mark Merryweather from Ontario designed this year's crest.
