This catalogue offers help in the selection of outdoor gear, and a great deal of written material is available in many absorbing books.

Experience, yours and others, is indeed the key to successful outdoor living, the reliable source of essential outdoor data that makes possible intelligent planning. Experience tells you the "what", "when", "where", "why", and "how" of camping and hiking. It teaches you how to meet nature on her own terms and have a wonderful time doing it. It is the experience of Boy Scouts and Leaders that has dictated the selection of Official Equipment on the following pages, to help you meet the vital test of outdoor planning: "Not too little, Not too much . . . Wait!

Before you delve into the pages of this Catalogue let us remind you that by the term "Scouting" is meant the work and attributes of back-woodsmen, explorers and frontiersmen. It is essentially an OUT-DOOR activity and can be enjoyed as such during the year round—in Summer and in Winter.

HOW TO PLAN FOR-

THE OUT-OF-DOORS

"Not too little . . .

Not too much . . .

Just what you need."
Follow this rule, and you're heading in the right direction for outdoor fun. The trick

YOUR UNIFORM

is to decide "just what you need".

Consider conditions ahead. Then choose the clothing that will best prepare you to meet them. The Scout Uniform Section of this catalogue will help you make the proper selection.

YOUR PACK

Your pack will be close to you every minute, so choose one that rides easily and is readily adjustable. Features to look for in a pack are size, roominess, and waterproofing.

YOUR COOKING GEAR

Meals are high spots of outdoor adventure. Carefully choose your cooking and eating outfits. If on a long overnight hike you'll need a waterbottle and a toilet kit to freshen up.

YOUR ASSORTED ESSENTIALS

Your knife and first aid kit are important. Belt axe, compass, flashlight, guard rope and notebook are other useful items.

YOUR TENT

Its selection should be governed by careful consideration of requirements. For hiking overnight the "Shelter" or "Hike" tent is what you require. Standing camps call for larger and roomier tentage.

YOUR SLEEPING GEAR

Choose a sleeping bag that is warm and comfortable, but not too bulky. Wool blankets will also serve well. A waterproof ground sheet is of course a necessity.

"BE PREPARED" FOR FUN

Remember these pointers when planning your next outdoor expedition, and you'll go "prepared" for fun and healthful action.

The "Why" of the Uniform

The Uniform is a part of the romance of Scouting. It is a symbol of the ideals and out-of-door activities for which the Movement stands. It has the picturesque touch and smartness which meets the love of distinctive dress that is innate in every boy, and the wearing adds appreciably to his personal pride and self respect.

The "Wearing" of the Uniform

Show your pride in your Uniform by making up your mind either to wear it or not to wear it. Don't make any half-way betweens. For many people the Uniform provides the only recognised contact with the Movement, and the impression made is chiefly that of the neatness (or otherwise) of the outfit, and the general bearing and conduct of the wearer.



The "Uniformity" of the Uniform

It is highly important to the regard in which Scouts and Cubs shall be held by the general public that their Uniform, like their conduct, should be orderly. Appearance in varied nondescript outlits creates an unfavourable impression. Every effort therefore should be made for each Troop and Peck to adopt a standard uniform from the "Official" outfits listed in this catalogue.



The Scout Uniform means many things. First, it means the Scout belongs, that he is a part of the international brotherhood of Scouting. Wherever he goes, his uniform is a warm introduction, especially to his brother Scouts. His uniform stands for service; it means he is prepared to help others. The uniform signifies democracy. Backgrounds — social, economic, or racial — do not count; the uniform is the same for everyone. When he's in uniform, all the world knows the boy is a Scout. He looks like a Scout. You are sure he will act like a Scout.

For many people the uniform provides the only recognized contact with Scouting and the impression made is chiefly that of the neatness (or otherwise) of the uniform, and the bearing of the wearer.

The neatness and smartness of the uniform meets the love of distinctive dress that is innate in every boy, and the wearing adds appreciably to his personal pride and self-respect. All of these reasons for wearing the uniform are also reasons for "Uniformity of the Uniform" within the Troop — similarity of neckerchief, colour of Shirt, Shorts, Stockings, etc. A Troop in standardized uniform is more conscious of its identity; it contributes to Troop pride — the foundation of loyalty.

While no boy should be kept out of Scouting because he cannot provide a uniform, every boy should be encouraged and inspired to earn the uniform. To be among the few without a uniform will give him the feeling of not belonging fully as do other boys. The uniform is not a luxury. It is durable and wearable on many occasions. It will save wear and tear on other clothes. It is economy in the end.

Remember! Proper uniforming starts with the Leader. If he is completely and properly uniformed the Scouts are bound to follow his example.



A Word to Lady Scouters

Please read the opposite page and by substituting "PACK" where "TROOP" is mentioned the entire write up applies equally to your Wolf Cub Pack. "Uniformity of the Uniform" within the Pack is just as desirable as within the Troop, and the illustration of a properly uniformed Cub will be of assistance in helping you "TO HAVE EVERY BOY IN YOUR PACK - "LOOK LIKE A CUB".

We feature for Lady Scouters and their Assistants a "suggested" uniform which is both serviceable and attractive. The outfit consists of the regulation Scout shirt in either Blue or Green to match the colour of the Jersey worn by the Pack, a Blue pleated skirt, regulation Scout belt and a Sports Felt Hat. (The Wolf Cub Cap is not permitted to be worn by Lady Scouters). Stockings should be of a colour to blend with the uniform and shoes should have fairly thick soles with medium heels.

NOTE: The Shirt and Belt are the only items available through this catalogue. The remainder of the uniform should be obtained through regular retail channels.



Wear Your Neckerchief Correctly

The Official Neckerchief is made of high-count cotton material, guaranteed wash-proof and sun-proof. It is perhaps the most characteristic and distinctive part of the uniform, and as such should be worn in the correct manner. There is nothing that detracts more from the smartness of the uniform than a sloppy or dirty neckerchief. It should always be clean, well pressed and, by following these simple steps when putting it on will assure the wearer of correctness: (1) Lay neckerchief on flat service and roll long edge back in even folds. (2) Place around neck over collar of shirt or jersey. (3) Draw neckerchief slide over ends and adjust to fit. (4) Tie ends in overhand knot as a reminder of the "Daily Good Turn."

A word about "THE SUPPLY OF NECKERCHIEFS"

Due to the continued world shortage of textiles it has been found impossible to supply the demand for this essential part of the uniform. Small and infrequent shipments are being received from our suppliers but not nearly of sufficient quantities to warrant listing in this catalogue. The Stores Department will, however, send on request a special list of colours and styles available and will endeavour to be of the best possible service under present conditions. "BE PREPARED"

It would take a tremendously large scrapbook to hold all the news stories about Wolf Cub and Boy Scout heroism. Yet, instead of publicity, the majority of these young heroes get the satisfaction of a good job well done.

When disaster strikes, one of the first agencies on the job is the local Boy Scout Organization. As other relief agencies commence operations, they immediately send out a call for Boy Scouts for routine and other duties.

The Scout motto, "Be Prepared", is a very live slogan. It is continuously practiced, and tested. No sooner is the Scout unpacked at summer camp than he is enrolled for instruction in swimming and rescue methods. Practically every other element in the Scouting programme points toward either quick action or quick thinking in emergencies.

So many times has Cub and Scout heroism gone far beyond the call of duiy, that the Canadian General Council of the Boy Scouts Association has found it advisable to make special awards for outstanding cases. The highest possible award for gallantry is the Bronze Cross when special heroism has been displayed or when extraordinary risks have been faced. The Silver Cross is awarded for gallantry with considerable risk, and the Gilt Cross for gallantry with moderate risk.

TRAPPED IN INFERNO OF PRAIRIE FIRE

Quick thinking, coolness and bravery on the part of Peter Kramarchuk of Carberry, Manitoba, are credited with saving his own and the lives of seven other youths. A sudden change in the direction of the wind resulted in the youths being trapped by the flames travelling at great speed through the long dry prairie grass.

The boys ran in an effort to reach safety but soon realized they could not keep ahead of the flames. It was then that Kramarchuk took command. He decided their only hope was to dig a slit trench. They set to work but the heat became so intense they were forced to quit digging. They suffered desperately from heat and thirst but Kramarchuk joked, told stories, and sang, preventing the others from panic. He even boiled surface water on a shovel to moisten their parched mouths. When finally rescued, the youths including Kramarchuk suffering severe burns and shock were taken to hospital for treatment.

For his special heroism, Peter Kramarchuk, Cubmaster of the Carberry Cub Pack, was awarded the Bronze Cross.

A 10 YEAR OLD CUB RESCUES A FRIEND

Wolf Cub Gordon St. Onge, a member of the 15th Pack of Windsor, Ontario, and his young friend, Maurice Paliwada, were playing on the ice floes in the Detroit River. When the ice cracked and gave way beneath his friend, plunging him into the icy water, Gordon, without thought of personal danger, ran out on the shell ice, grabbed Maurice by the coat collar, and with considerable difficulty dragged him to shore.

This young Wolf Cub showed a wonderful presence of mind and remarkable bravery on the tricky ice floes and in the freezing water to save his friend's life. It required courage and determination to keep hold on Maurice and get him to shore without any assistance. His action is even more commendable because of his youth and the fact that his own life was endangered by large ice floes and the risk of drowning in the freezing water.

Because of his gallantry with considerable risk, Wolf Cub Gordon St. Onge was awarded the Silver Cross.

A ROVER SCOUT RESCUES HIS UNCLE

As a relief from the heat of the day Rover Scout Henri Chabot, a member of the 1st Sherbrooke Troop, Quebec, and his three uncles went bathing in the Eaton river.

One of his uncles. Armand, who was unable to swim, went in beyond his depth and began to struggle and flounder in the water. Henri, who could swim, went immediately to his aid while his other two uncles went for help. Although alone and not skilful at diving or swimming underwater, Henri dove ten or twelve times in the muddy water until he recovered the inanimate body of his uncle. He dragged him to shore and applied artificial respiration. When help came, although his uncle had not regained consciousness, he was breathing strongly. Unfortunately Armand Chabot died of complications three days later.

For doing exceptionally well in a case of emergency though without special risk to himself, Rover Scout Henri Chabot was awarded the Gilt Cross.




