(SIZE 9) ENLARGE SCALE DRAWING & CUT PATTERNS FOR FRONT & BACK. LAY PATTERNS ON DOUBLE THICKNESS OF STRETCHED AND CRUSHED GREY CREPE, PIN & CUT. SEAM 2 FRONT SECTIONS TOGETHER, STITCH FRONT & BACK SECTIONS TOGETHER AT INSIDE SEAMS. TURN UNDER & STITCH BELT FACING UNDER NARROW FACING ALLOWANCE AT TOP OF BACK. ADD SEALS.



## ⑥ BUCKSKIN



MEASURE ACROSS BODY FROM WRIST TO WRIST. USE THIS MEASUREMENT FOR LENGTH, MAKE 20" WIDE. CUT 2 PIECES, CUT HOLE & SLIT IN A & B AS SHOWN. BY FOLDING PAPER UP YOU HAVE ONLY TO MAKE A FEW SWIRLS WITH THE SCISSORS TO MAKE FRINGE. REINFORCE INSIDE OF NECK WITH MASKING TAPE. SEW A & B TOGETHER AROUND NECK & UP SLEEVES 5" (SEE NECK DETAIL ABOVE)



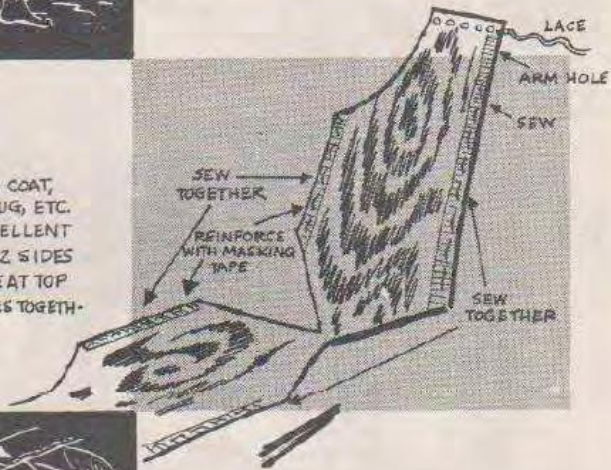

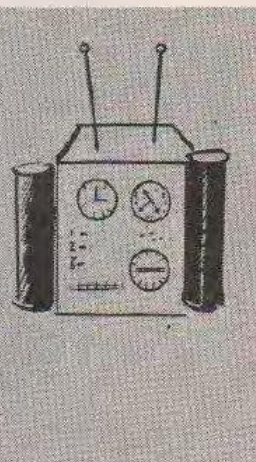
## 2 ARMS & LEGS

## 3 MOON BOOTS

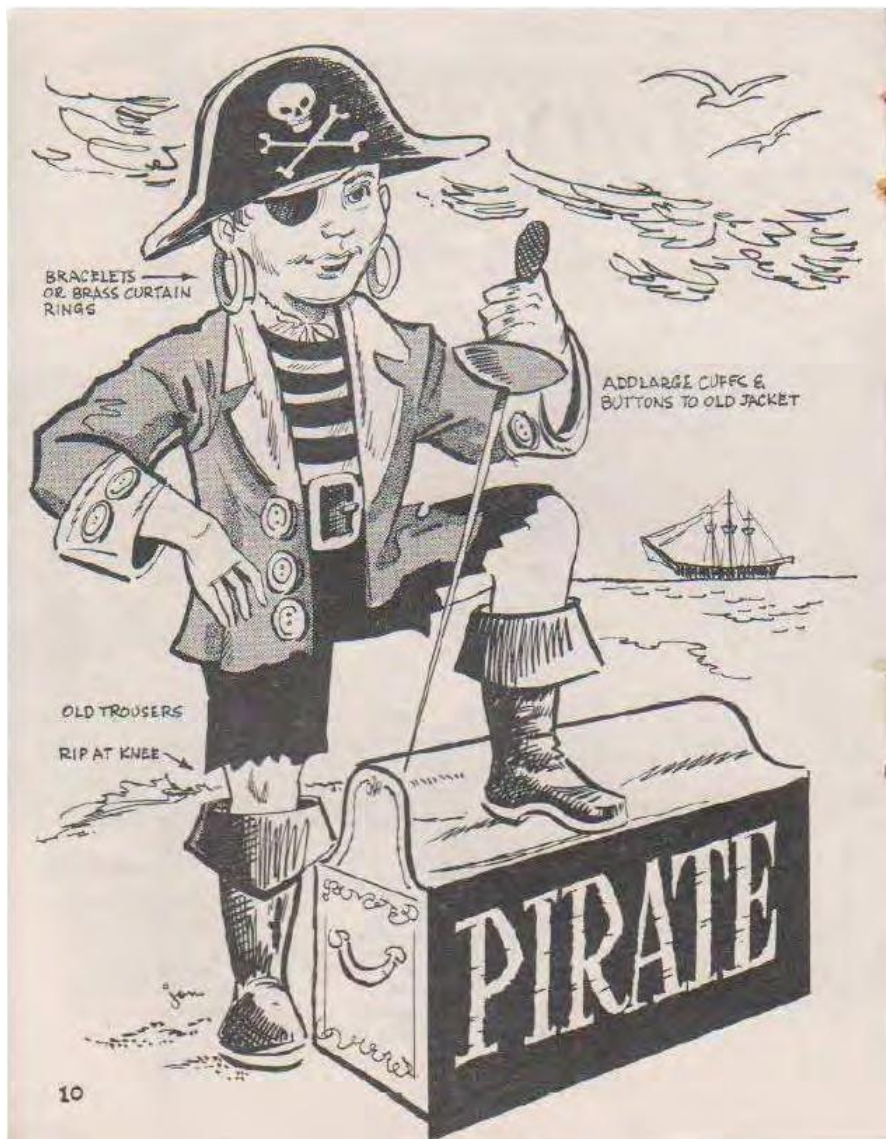

THIS IS MADE FROM SMALL CARDBOARD BOX, 2 TOILET ROLLS, WIRE & PAINT. GLUE ROLLS TO SIDE OF BOX & PAINT DIALS, NUMBERS ETC. ON FACE. ADD WIRE ANTENNAE



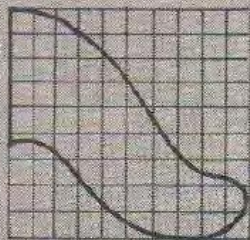

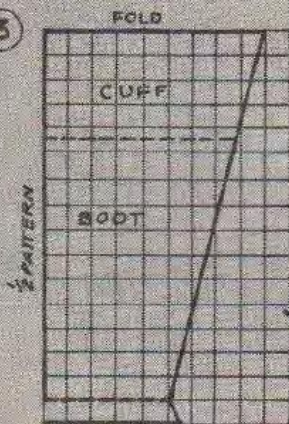

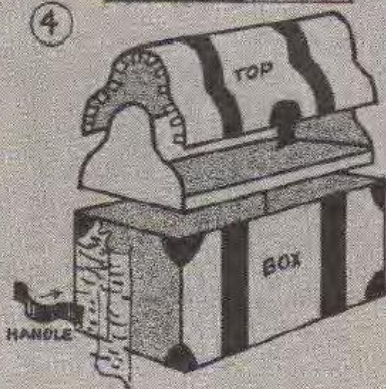

2 **HAT**- CUT 2 HATS FROM BLACK STOCK. FOLLOW PATTERN. PASTE HATS TOGETHER AT TIPS. CUT A STRIP 1 X 9" & PASTE INSIDE OF HAT AS SHOWN. GLUE SKULL AND CROSS BONES ON FRONT

3 **BOOT TOPS**- CUT A DOUBLE THICKNESS OF BLACK CREPE. FOLLOW PATTERN. PASTE EDGES TOGETHER. FOLD BOTTOM UP TO FORM A 1" SEAM. PASTING TO HOLD. RUN A SHOESTRING THROUGH SEAM TO TIE AROUND ANKLE. FOLD DOWN CUFF & TIE WITH ANOTHER SHOESTRING.

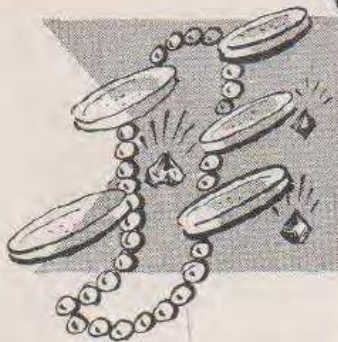
4 **TREASURE CHEST**- USE A LARGE DEEP BOX WITH A COVER. CUT 2 CURVED SIDE PIECES FROM CARDBOARD & PASTE TO COVER. PASTE A LARGE SHEET OF CARDBOARD OVER SIDES TO FORM TOP. STRETCH & CRUSH ENOUGH BROWN CREPE TO COVER ALL SIDES OF BOX. PASTE CREPE TO BOX. TAPE COVER TO BOX. CUT HARDWARE FROM BLACK GUMMED CREPE.





5 EARRINGS- STICK TWO #27 GOLD NOTARIAL SEALS BACK TO BACK OVER A LOOP OF STRING

6 COINS & GEMS- EITHER GET WOODEN DISKS FROM LUMBER YARD OR PLUGS FROM ELECTRICAL BOXES FIND STONES FOR GEMS & USE A STRING OF OLD PEARLS.



7 SWORD- ANY SUITABLE BRANCH WILL DO. SHAPE IT WITH ROUGH SANDPAPER. THE SHIELD IS A METAL FUNNEL

8 SKULLE CROSSBONES- CUT OUT OF WHITE STOCK. PAINT IN EYES, NOSE & TEETH



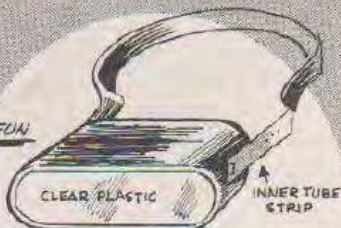

- 3 HAT- CUT 2 HATS FROM PATTERN USING GREEN CREPE. PASTE TOGETHER ALONG EDGE & FOLD UP BRIM. GLUE ON FEATHER



SHERWOOD FOREST WILL NEVER BE THE SAME ONCE YOU GET INTO THIS COSTUME. BROWN & GREEN ARE THE COLOURS.



- 4 BOW & ARROW- ANY BOY WORTH HIS SALT DOESN'T HAVE TO BE TOLD HOW TO MAKE THIS. DO BE CAREFUL WHERE YOU SHOOT YOUR ARROWS



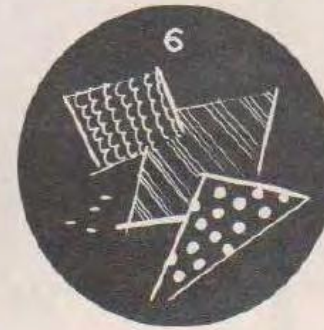
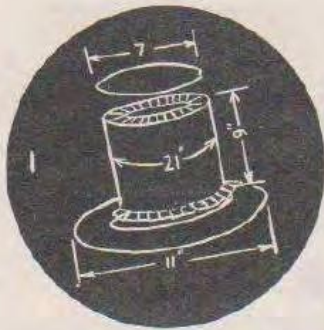

### CONQUISTADOR'S CUIRASS WITH TASSES

ENLARGE ALL PATTERN PIECES TO SIZE FROM FIG. 1 AND CUT THE NUMBER INDICATED FROM HEAVY WRAPPING PAPER. LAY OUT ON SILVER CREPE PAPER AS SHOWN IN FIG. 2, AND GLUE TO CREPE CUT OUT CREPE LEAVING EXTRA PORTION ALL AROUND. PRESS UNDER HEAVY WEIGHTS UNTIL DRY. TRIM OFF EXCESS AND PUNCH HOLES WITH PAPER PUNCH. TURN BACK FACING ALLOWANCE AT CENTRE FRONT ON BOTH FRONTS. ATTACH FRONTS TO BACKS WITH  $\frac{1}{2}$  BRASS PAPER FASTENERS. ATTACH SIDES SIMILARLY USING HOLES THAT GIVE BEST FIT. FASTEN TASSES AND SHOULDER PIECES, LACE FRONT.

### JACK BOOTS

MEASURE FROM ANKLE TO MID-HIGH AND LAY OUT THIS MEASUREMENT ON GREY CREPE PAPER. DRAW PATTERN ON 1 PIECE AND USE THIS TO CUT 3 OTHERS. STAPLE TOGETHER AT SIDES AND NOTCH TOPS, TURN DOWN CUFF

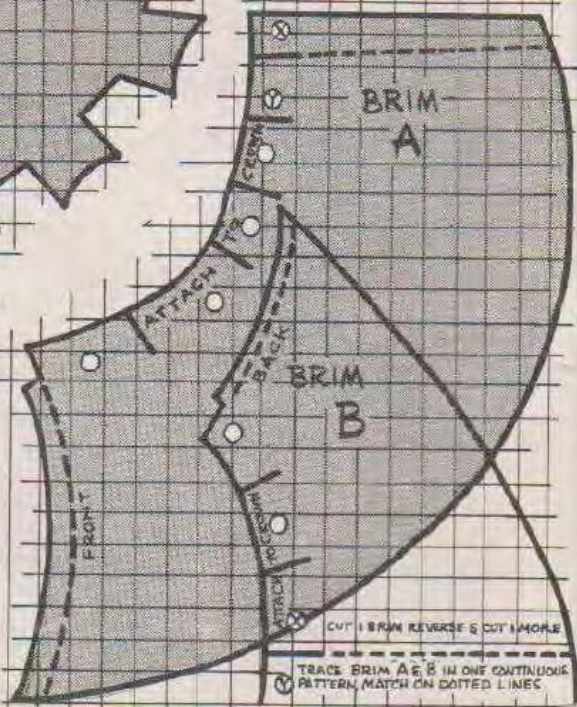
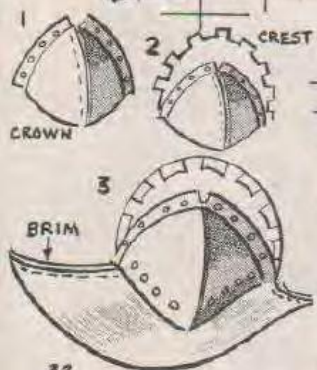


**CONQUISTADOR'S HELMET**

TRACE PATTERNS AS INDICATED AND CUT EACH PIECE FROM SILVER MAT STOCK. PUNCH HOLES WITH PAPER PUNCH. STAPLE 2 CROWN SECTIONS TOGETHER (WRONG SIDES TOGETHER). CREASE WHERE INDICATED AND ATTACH TO 1 CREST SECTION WITH 3/4" PAPER FASTENERS. FASTEN HALF CROWN SECTION TO HALF BRIM SECTION AS SHOWN. ASSEMBLE THE OTHER HALF CROWN, CREST & BRIM IN THE SAME WAY. PUT 2 HALVES TOGETHER. FOLD & PASTE DOWN TABS ON CREST. STAPLE BRIM SECTIONS TOGETHER AT CENTER FRONT & BACK AS INDICATED

**NOTE**

ONE SQUARE EQUALS 1/2" SQUARE

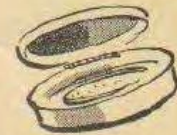


TRACE BRIM A & B IN ONE CONTINUOUS PATTERN. MATCH ON DOTTED LINES

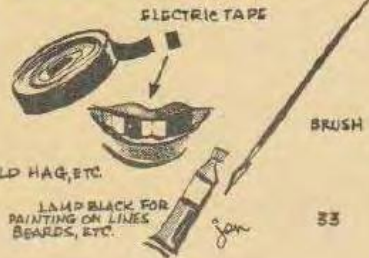
